



When will the district notify staff and families about a COVID-19 CASE?

NO notification to a student or staff of the school community will be made if a student or staff:

- Is symptomatic and at home **OR**
- Does not have symptoms but is a close contact of a confirmed or presumed positive case **OR**
- Is not physically present during the infection period **OR**
- Tests negative for COVID-19

Notification to staff and families will be made **IF** and **THEN**:

- **IF** a BAISD **staff member or student of our programs or services tests positive and is physically present during the infection period, **THEN** the health department will handle contact tracing, identify and communicate with *close contacts, direct any required isolation or quarantine and determine classroom, building, or district closure, if needed.
- **IF** a BAISD **staff member or student of our programs or services is impacted **THEN** they will be notified by BAISD administration and the health department regarding findings and directives.

- **IF** information is shared with BAISD administration from a **local district** about a positive or presumed positive case of COVID-19 **THEN** the information from the local district will be shared by administration with staff and families who provide services or participate in a program in the local district.

*A close contact is defined as anyone who has been within 6 feet of the infected person for at least 15 minutes.
** The name of the staff or student who is positive or presumed positive **will not** be shared with staff or families by the HD or BAISD administration.
*** Vaccinated staff and students do not meet the definition of close contact so notification is not needed.
